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7 - Statement regarding the distribution of property remaining on liquidation

Any property remaining on liquidation of the Corporation, after discharge of liabilities, shall be distributed to the members in equal shares.

8 - Additional provisions, if any

a. The corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members, and any profits or other accretions to the corporation shall be used in furtherance of its purposes.

b. The directors may appoint one or more directors, who shall hold office for a term expiring ** not later than the close of the next annual general meeting of members, but the total number of directors so appointed may not exceed one-third of the number of directors elected at the previous annual general meeting of members.

**Comment: Corinne Rivers - "if you wish to be able to appoint directors [member of the public- non cvrp member] this a must be here before you put it in the bylaws"
