Professional Practice Committee Report

The purpose of the College's Professional Practice Committee is to:

- develop, maintain and review scope of practice and services which members of the college are authorized to perform based on their certification with the College
- develop, maintain and review the Standards of Practice and programs to ensure continued competence of members
- provide continuing education direction and opportunities for members
- assess referred allegations or concerns about a member's capacity to practice
- provide guidance and recommendations to the Registrar, Assistant Registrar, and the Board of Directors on matters concerning professional practice in keeping with the mandate of the College to protect the public

The Professional Practice Committee has met regularly over the past year. The focus has been on:

- reviewing and further developing the scope of practice statements for the various certifications of the College, including for CVRP and CCVE and the two new certifications: Return to Work Disability Managers (RTWDM) and Certified Forensic Life Care Planners (CFLCP)
- developing definitions of various services provided by vocational rehabilitation professionals to enable members and the public to distinguish between the expertise of the various types of certifications provided by the College
- reviewing and further developing the College's Standards of Practice and

Practice Guidelines

Over the next year, the Professional Practice Committee will meet regularly to continue to review and further develop the College's Standards of Practice and Practice Guidelines and develop same for the College's certifications, including the CVRP and CCVE certifications and the new certifications, Return to Work Disability Managers (RTWDM) and Certified Forensic Life Care Planners (CFLCP).

thank the Registration Committee for working closely with the Professional Practice Committee in developing the scopes of practice, service definitions and the Standards of Practice.
