

CANADIAN DISABILITY MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS - 2020

1. **Dalhousie University** offers an on-line certificate program in Disability Management. It is offered by the Faculty of Occupational Therapy on a part-time basis and students in faculties other than Occupational Therapy can apply. Please see the website for pre-requisites.
2. **Pacific Coast University** offers a bachelor's degree in Disability Management (B.D.M.) and an Advanced Certificate in Return-to-Work. They also offer a University Studies Education program where prospective students can enroll on individual courses. They have a Continuing Education division which offers the Disability Management Practitioner Certificate Program and seven additional courses that can be taken on an individual basis. Not all courses are offered on-line, but many are.
3. **Seneca College** offers a Seneca College Rehabilitation Certificate Program on a part-time, on-line basis. Courses included domain areas such as medical/psychological issues, assessment, case management, ethics, etc. that are applicable to disability management.
4. **Seneca College/York University** offer a joint rehabilitation program in which graduates receive both a degree and a certificate. The Seneca courses offered in the joint program are different than the ones offered in the Rehabilitation Certificate Program and they are full-time and not offered on-line.
5. **Simon Fraser University** offers a Rehabilitation and Disability Management diploma program in their Faculty of Continuing Education. It is part-time, in-person studies: eight courses that are 2-3 days each in duration. An Ethics course is also offered. The website refers to CVRP but as a designation and not a certification.
6. **The University of Northern British Columbia** offers a master's degree in Disability Management and refers to this degree as "the first and only". It can be done on-line as well as in-class and is a part time program.
7. **The University of Alberta** offers a 39-hour course called "the Fundamentals of Disability Management. This is an in-person course and, to date, is the only disability management course offered.
8. **The British Columbia Institute of Technology (B.C.I.T.)** offers a 42-hour on-line course entitled "Disability Case Management". This is also the only course offered in the field at this educational institution.
9. **Mohawk College** offers a graduate certificate program in "Mental Health and Disability Management". It is offered over three semesters and is a combination of on-line and in-person courses.
10. **The University of Guelph** offers a certificate in Disability Management. There are four classroom-based courses, each of four days duration with the exam written on the fifth day. The course is 30 hours in length.

11. **The University of Fredericton** is an on-line only university. Two Disability Management programs are offered. The part-time Certificate in Integrated Disability Management can be completed in 16 weeks. The Diploma in Integrated Disability Management can be completed on a part-time basis and if only one course is taken at a time, it can be completed in eighteen months.

DISABILITY STUDIES PROGRAMS

1. **The University of Windsor** offers an undergraduate degree in Disability Studies.
2. **Brock University** offers two programs in Disability Studies: a master's degree in Applied Disability Studies and a diploma program. The programs offer some courses that are specific to Disability Management including medical/psychological conditions, ethics, psychometrics, etc.
3. **Bow Valley College** offers an in-class Certificate in Disability Studies which has Disability Management content. Once completing the certificate, graduates can then move into the two-year Disability Studies Diploma program.
4. **The University of British Columbia** offers a master's Program in Vocational Rehabilitation.
5. **The University of Calgary** offers both bachelor's and master's degrees in Community Rehabilitation which are rehabilitation counselling based but do have some courses that would be applicable to Disability Management. Many graduates of both programs work in the Disability Management field.
6. **The University of Winnipeg** offers an interdisciplinary degree program in Disability Studies.
7. **Stout University in Wisconsin** offers a degree in Rehabilitation Studies A number of Canadian students have completed this program and work in the rehabilitation field.
8. **Vancouver Island University** offers a bachelor's degree in Disability Studies.
9. **Ryerson University** offers a bachelor's degree in Disability Studies. It is a post-diploma degree program and is offered on-line.
10. **Red River College** offers a two-year diploma program in Disability and Community Support. Graduates from this program can then transfer to the University of Winnipeg's degree program in Disability Studies.
11. **King's University College** offers a 5-course certificate program in Disability Studies
12. **Douglas College** offers an Advanced Certificate program in Disability and Applied Behaviour Analysis.
